



## Korg opsix Biosphere Sound Pack Installation Guide and License Conditions

**Before transferring sound sets to your synth, please back up your patches first!**

**To load the opsix Sound Pack into your unit:**

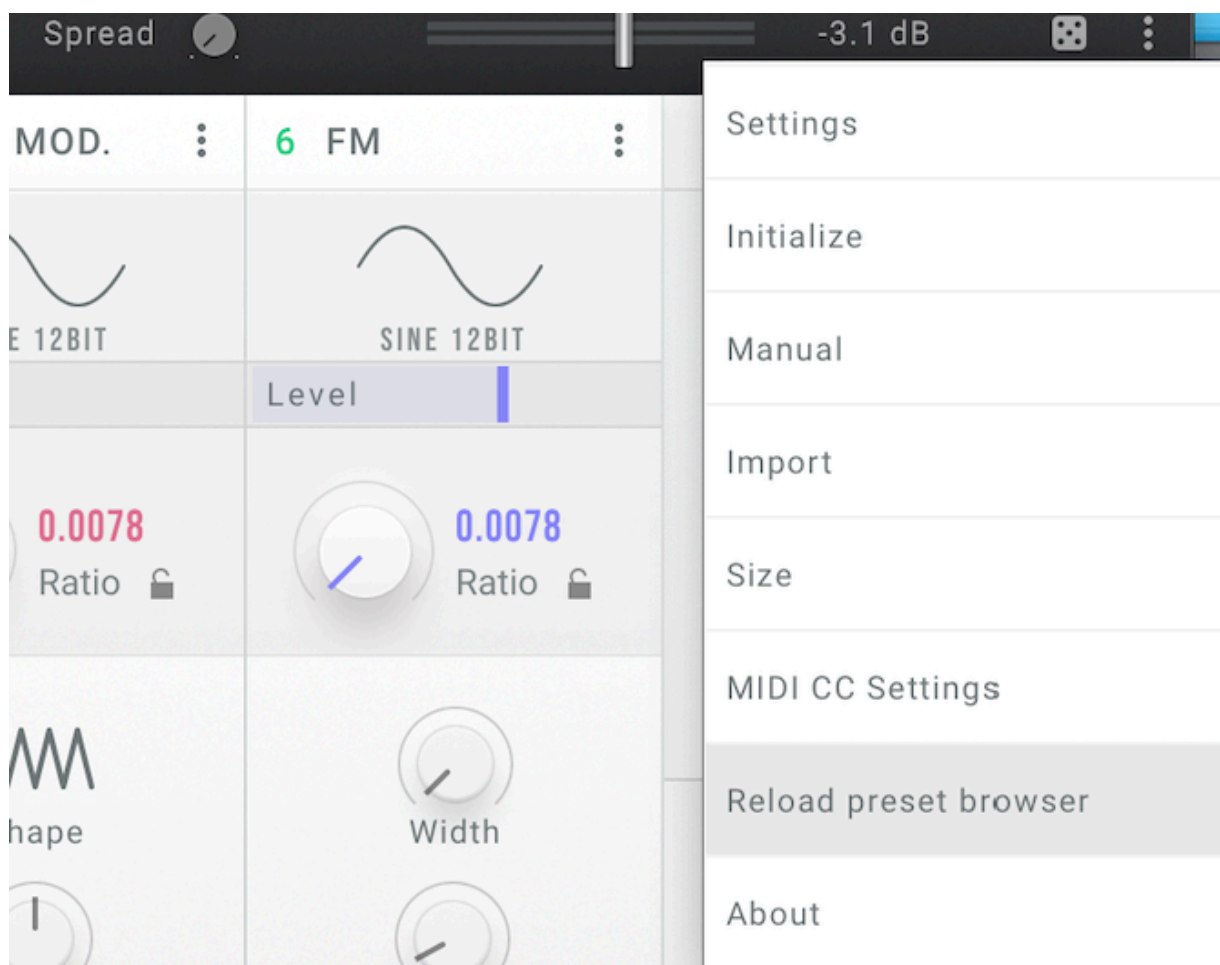
1. Make sure you're using the latest OS and librarian software. You can find them here: <https://www.korg.com/us/support/download/product/0/874/#software>
2. Switch on the synth, connect it via USB to your computer, and wait until it's ready.
3. Open the opsix sound librarian software.
4. The librarian will ask if you want to import your current opsix (hardware) library. Confirm, and make sure to back up your work by saving your library to your computer. (*File → Save Library*)
5. You can now either drag and drop individual programs, or transfer all programs at once to a location of your choice. Please note that this will replace existing programs, so it's recommended to search for empty slots first. This is the easiest way to preserve your existing library.
6. Alternatively, you can load the complete library by choosing *Load Library* in the opsix librarian. In that case, go to *File → Open Library → Load Library* and select **Korg\_Opsix\_Limbic\_Bits\_Biosphere**. This will replace the patches in positions 1–64, overwriting the factory patches.
7. Once you have placed the sound bank and patches, transfer them to your opsix unit by clicking *Send All* or *Send Selected Programs*.
8. Done!

# opsix native plugin

Drag and drop the folder “**Limbic Bits Biosphere Opsix Native**” into the following location:

- **Windows:**  
My Documents\KORG\opsix native\Presets\
- **macOS:**  
Documents/KORG/opsix native/Presets/

After this, “**Limbic Bits Biosphere**” will appear as a Bank in the opsix Native Program Browser. If you can’t see it immediately, try “Reload Preset browser”.



You can store programs directly in these new folders. You can also reorganize programs into banks by using Finder (macOS) or Explorer (Windows) to move .op6program files between folders. Depending on your version of opsix native, you may need to re-launch the plugin before the changes are recognized. 🎵

## Trouble Shooting

In case something went wrong, please try these things:

1. Use a direct USB connection instead of a USB HUB
2. Try a different USB cable
3. Make sure you have the latest opsix firmware version
